Turtle #45 - Is over 20 years old and is our first educational ambassador! He was brought to us in the winter of 2015. He was kept illegally as a pet and tossed into the snow when his caretaker was away. The turtle was badly malnourished and too friendly to be released back to the wild. He resides at Wild Care where he warms the hearts of everyone he greets. **Sponsorship for one year is \$700.**



Nickerson - Also came to us as an owlet after his nesting tree was cut down in Nickerson State Park in June of 2015. Nickerson suffered an eye injury and could not be released. A delightfully charming owl, you can find Nickerson at events, schools and more. **Sponsorship for one year is \$1,000.**
