For the past 29 years, Wild Care has cared for over 30,000 animals representing 275 species, including songbirds, seabirds, waterfowl, raptors, amphibians, reptiles, small mammals, and even butterflies.

Looking back on the past year, we have many things to be grateful for. We stood strong despite Avian Influenza, provided a warm comforting place for 903 orphaned animals that arrived at our door, administered oxygen, meds and veterinary care to every animal in need, and hosted our first large in-person event since Covid, our “Wild Baby Shower”. This event was critical in helping us to get much needed supplies for our baby season.

Most of all, we are thankful for the opportunity to give a second chance to over 1,700 sick, injured, and orphaned wild animals this year, thanks to your support. 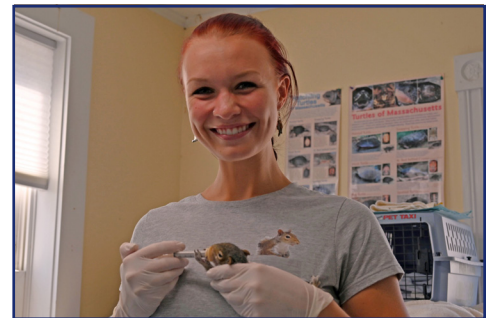
