WILDCARE, Inc. is an independent, emergency wildlife clinic that is involved in the rescue and rehabilitation of injured, ill, and orphaned wild animals. We intake approximately 1500-2000 animals every year, and rely heavily on our volunteer team to help with daily operations. Our volunteers are a necessity to the success of our organization, and we seek caring people who are reliable, respectful, and trustworthy. The animals brought to our door are highly stressed and need time to heal, so we also seek understanding people who will provide a quiet, and respectful environment for them. Volunteer participation is key to all of our programs to help wildlife.

We are reviewing applications continuously and will be in touch with you typically within a couple of days of receipt of your application, to discuss how your availability and experience can fit in with our needs. Wild Care volunteers must be at least 18 years of age, and must have an up-to-date Tetanus vaccination. (Ages 16-17 are accepted for the Baby Bird program, with a partner over the age of 18.)

Be aware that this is **not** an opportunity for individuals primarily interested in photography, handling, or personal, repetitive contact with wildlife. **Unlike zoos, museums, and aquariums, the animals we accommodate are not for display, fundraising, educational, entertainment, or training purposes. They are here to recover from being orphaned, injured, or ill, and are intended to be returned to the wild.**
