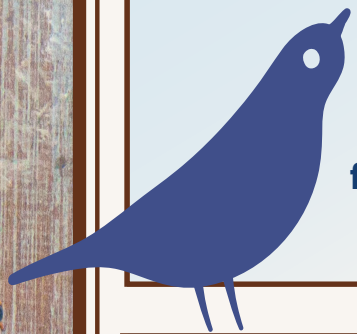


Save BIRDS From Window Strikes

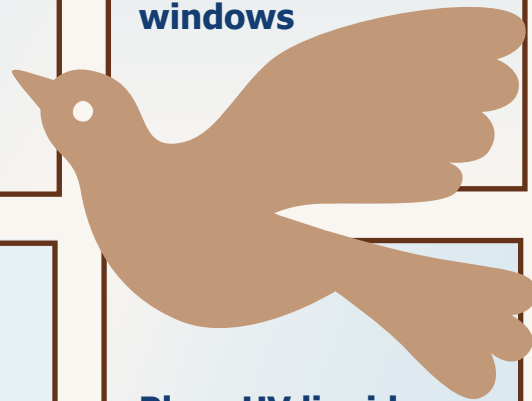
Homes account for the greatest number of window collision fatalities.



Of the nearly 3 billion birds lost, 90% came from just 12 bird families, including sparrows, warblers, finches, and swallows.

GET KIDS INVOLVED

Colorful tape, glass writing crayons, tempera paint on outside of windows



LIGHTS OUT!
Turn off unnecessary outdoor lighting. It can be disorienting to migratory birds especially during inclement weather.

Hundreds of millions of birds are killed each year by colliding with windows.

Place UV liquid or decals on your windows to break the reflection.

(UV Liquid sold at WindowAlert.com)

Remedies include screens, decals, tape, and keeping the shades down to reduce reflections.

Correct installation is important: To be effective, place stickers, decals, and other prevention methods over the entire outside of window, no more than 3-4" apart from one another.
